

HASA Executive Committee Meeting

August 10, 2009

Lori Garretson brought the meeting to order at 10:00 am.

Treasurer's Report: Kim Gillie handed out ledger sheets from last year to current committee chairs. Kim said she will try to get reimburse checks to anyone within one week of turning in a receipt. Kim reminded everyone to use SCRIP to make purchases for committees such as pizza, supplies, etc.

Committee Reports

SCRIP

Angie Brown and Sarah Maxson gave the report for SCRIP profits from last school year. Families earned \$43,637.30 in school tuition for SJSE, Bishop Luers, and Bishop Dwenger. SCRIP gave HASA a profit check for \$31,000.00. Angie stated that shipping is a big expense for SCRIP, totaling \$878.00 last year. Some changes for this year include Meijer at 4%, The Stand on Bluffton Rd., Coventry Auto Wash, and Scott's/Kroger going down to 3% profit instead of 5% profit. SCRIP was explained to all those attending Seton Fest to insure that all parishioners understand the benefits of purchasing SCRIP. Some tips for purchasing SCRIP include purchasing Visa cards at 2% profit for all purchases you may not have SCRIP for or at places not offering SCRIP, and also purchasing gift cards at Scott's/Kroger such as Target to get the 3% profit.
